

ACTS 3:1-11

Read Acts 3:1-11 in a few different translations. What stands out from your reading? What is the main point of this passage?

QUESTIONS

1) What does the man expect from Peter and James? Where are people looking to meet their needs and solve their problems?

2) Where are you tempted to give “silver and gold” instead of the gospel? Do you really believe the Gospel is the answer to people’s deepest issues and struggles?

3) How is the man’s physical condition a picture of a deeper need in his life?

4) Who in your life might be “sitting at the gate” waiting for you? What would it take for you to courageously share the Gospel with them?

5) Spend some time praying and asking God to give you this kind of boldness in your life.

RECLAIMED NIGHT PRAYER GUIDE

- Spend some time praying for Reclaimed Night.
- Celebrate and praise God for those taking this step of baptism.
- Thank God for the people who’ve invested in these individuals.
- Pray for 100 baptisms!
