

PROJECT GENESIS

What is Project Genesis?

- *Project Genesis is our annual one-day event to welcome rising 6th graders into our student ministry. We know the transition into student ministry is a big change for these students and want to get them started well. Project Genesis was created to help 6th graders make connections with their peers and fellow 6th graders, while meeting the student ministry staff, leadership, and select upperclassmen.*

What does the registration cost include?

- *Registration cost includes everything your student will need for the day including meals, supplies, and a new MVMNT t-shirt!*

What kind of supervision will there be?

- *There will be Venture Church staff members, along with existing KXP and MVMNT leaders. All adult leaders are background checked. Project Genesis will also include upperclassmen who exhibit maturity and leadership qualities. These upperclassmen will help lead the rising 6th graders and allow 6th graders to hear from current students about The MVMNT. Small Groups are lead by same-gender leaders.*

Does my child need to bring any spending money?

- *No, your child does not need any spending money for this day, unless noted in your campus details.*

What meals will be provided?

- *Any meals during Project Genesis will be provided by Venture Church, with allergies taken into account. Please review your campus tentative schedule and details to learn what meals will happen at Project Genesis.*

What is The MVMNT?

- *The MVMNT is the Sunday programming for our student ministry. The MVMNT happens on Sunday evenings. A typical night at The MVMNT looks like hanging out, playing games, and eating together before heading into a time of worship and teaching.*

How do I know which campus to attend?

- *If you have a Venture Church campus you attend, choose to attend that Project Genesis. If you do not have a home campus, you can choose to attend with a friend, or reach out to a team member and we will help connect you with a campus.*

If I cannot make the Project Genesis for my campus, can I attend a different one?

- *We highly encourage you to attend with your home campus, but if the other campus dates work better for your schedule, you may choose to attend there.*
